

## SUSTAINABILITY POLICY

### 1—Objects

- 1) That the AULSS shall attempt to reduce waste, conserve resources, and promote recycling while carrying out its business and activities.
- 2) That the AULSS shall promote environmentally friendly practices to its members, the Adelaide Law School, and stakeholders where appropriate.

### 2—Definitions

**where practicable** means in circumstances where such actions referred to are possible, cost effective, and not otherwise unreasonably detrimental to the affairs of the AULSS.

### 3—Interpretation

Interpretation of this policy is within the jurisdiction of the Executive.

### 4—Waste and recycling

- 1) The AULSS shall, by its resolutions and decisions, endeavour to minimise all forms of physical waste that it creates in the course of its business and activities.
- 2) The AULSS shall endeavour to work alongside the Adelaide Law School, external stakeholders and its members to promote environmentally friendly initiatives.
- 3) The AULSS shall keep a soft plastics bin within the AULSS Office which the Vice-President, or their delegate, shall be responsible for maintaining.

### 5—Paper and paper products

- 1) The AULSS shall endeavour to, where practicable, source paper and paper products that are recycled, or partially recycled, for usage in its business and activities.
- 2) The AULSS shall, where practicable, avoid printing documents and instead shall attempt to conduct its business and activities in a manner that reduces unnecessary paper usage.
